

## SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Proof of **Ancestry** (photocopy of status card, beneficiary identification, or letter from a community member)
- A copy of an **acceptance letter** from an accredited post-secondary or educational institute or a copy of your most recent transcript, as well as a copy of your current semester's schedule
- A written (1-2 page) or recorded (3-5 minutes) **personal introduction** detailing who you are, how this scholarship would help you in achieving your academic goals, and your career ambitions in the utilities sector or with engineering consulting

## ELEGIBILITY CRITERIA:

This bursary is available to **Indigenous full-time students**, enrolled in any year of **post secondary** education related to Primary's areas of business. Those being: **Electrical Engineering and Technology**, **Telecommunications Engineering**, **Powerline Technician**, **Drafting**, **Surveying**, **Civil Engineering and Technology**, **IT**, **Business**.
