Do I need to apply?

Part-time students must apply to this program through <u>ontariocolleges.ca</u> Use the code INDX. (This is the program code on OCAS.)


Can I take this program online?

Part-time students enrolled in the Interior Decorating Diploma take courses along with the fulltime students. There are no courses specifically scheduled in the evening. Courses are delivered on campus (there are 3 courses that are typically delivered online). The course schedules (day/time) usually becomes available 6 weeks prior to the semester start date.

Communications and General Education courses are available online.

How do I know which courses to take? Where can I see course fees?

What is the cost of the program?

There is no program fee when studying part-time. As a part-time student, you can take 1, 2 or 3 courses at a time in any given semester. Payment is per course, as you register.

Can I transfer credits/use prior learning?

The Credit for Prior Learning centre assists with:

- Transferring courses completed at another accredited institution which may be eligible for transfer towards your education at Georgian.
- Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) students can challenge course requirements based on relevant work or life skills and knowledge gained.
